

## Inpatient Senior Cross-Coverage Guide

When you are in clinic or post-nights, another senior resident must be identified to cover your service. The interns need to have a senior resident to contact in-house in case of an acute event or admission. **Additionally, a senior resident should be present on all inpatient rounds.**

**A senior resident should be able to cover two services** (depending on census) so please try to utilize inpatient seniors as much as possible. Residents on jeopardy should expect to cover for clinics 3-4 times per month. **If you are unable to find cross-coverage and need jeopardy, please reach out to the chiefs ASAP in advance of the shift. We are happy to help!**

*Order of contacts to cross cover if you are in clinic or post-night shift should you be unable to identify an inpatient senior for coverage:*

### **Gen Med**

1. Admission Senior
2. Other Gen Med team seniors
3. SCC Senior
4. PL3 or PL2 on jeopardy

### **Pulmonary**

1. Other residents on Pulm
2. SCC Senior
3. PL3 or PL2 on jeopardy

### **GI**

1. Rheum/Endo inpatient senior (if <12)
2. SCC Senior
3. PL3 or PL2 on jeopardy
4. NS/elective resident

### **Endocrinology/Rheumatology**

1. SCC Senior
2. GI inpatient senior (if <18)
3. PL3 or PL2 on jeopardy
4. NS/elective resident

### **Heme-Onc**

1. Heme/Onc elective senior
2. SCC senior
3. PL3 or PL2 on jeopardy

### **Neurology**

1. SCC Senior
2. Kidney inpatient senior (if <10)
3. Cardiology inpatient senior
4. PL3 or PL2 on jeopardy
5. NS/elective resident

### **Kidney**

1. SCC Senior
2. Neurology inpatient senior (if <10)
3. Cardiology inpatient senior
4. PL3 or PL2 on jeopardy
5. NS/elective resident

### **Cardiology**

1. Cards/elective senior
2. SCC Senior
3. Neurology inpatient senior (if <10)
4. Kidney inpatient senior (if <10)
5. PL3 or PL2 on jeopardy
6. NS/elective resident
